

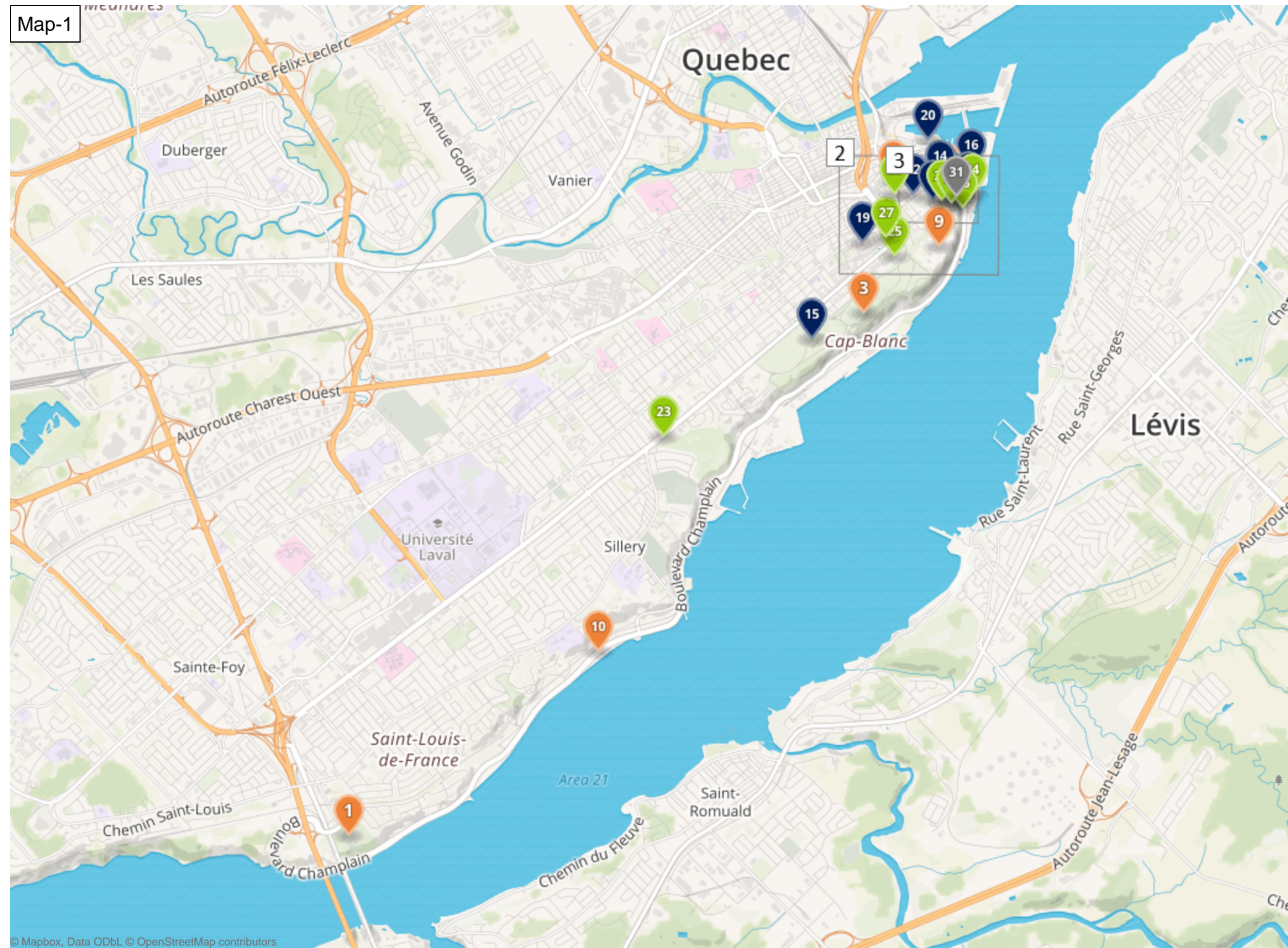

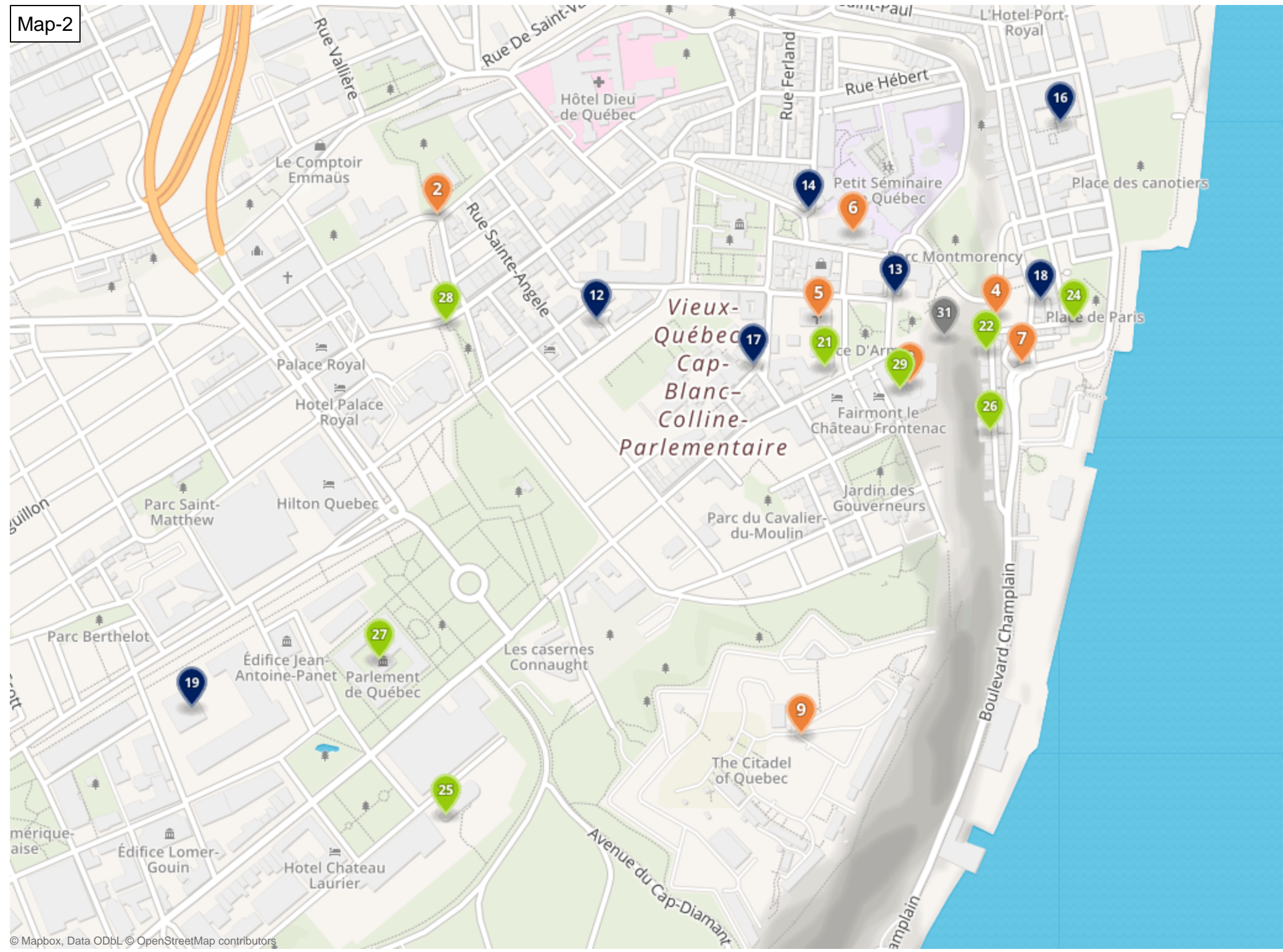
## Map of Attractions

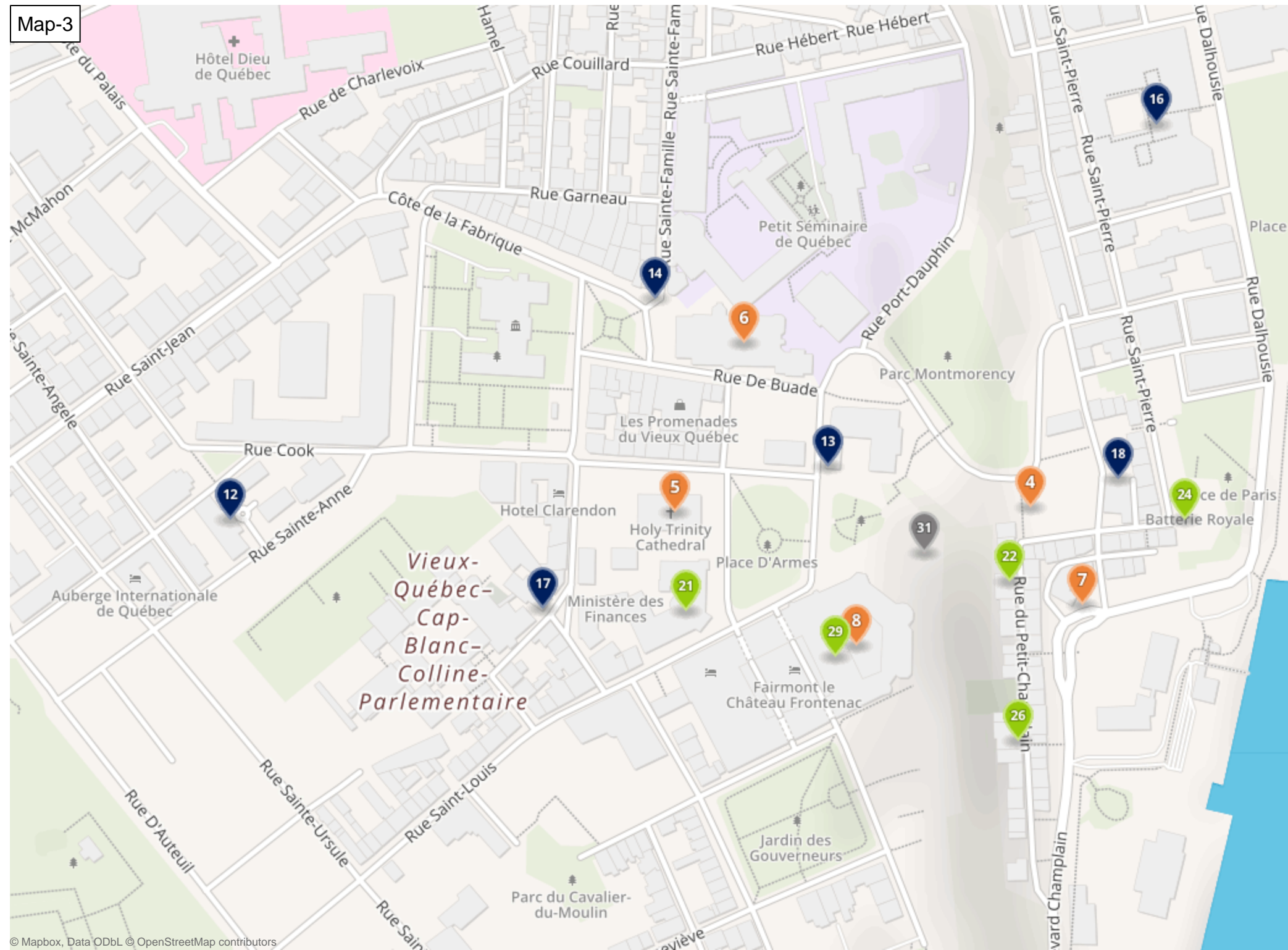

- 1** **Aquarium du Quebec**  
Home to over 10,000 marine animals for awesome indoor and outdoor activities (Map-1)
- 2** **Artillery Park National Historic Site**  
A complex of structures which served the French and British forces from the 17th century onwards (Map-1,2)
- 3** **Battlefields Park**  
267 acre urban park featuring gardens, fields, military monuments and recreational spots (Map-1)
- 4** **Breakneck Steps**  
59 steps so named for their sharp inclination, located in North America's oldest commercial district (Map-1,2,3)
- 5** **Cathedral of the Holy Trinity**  
A handsome church built in 1800 with 8 bells, a stunning silver collection and impressive interior (Map-1,2,3)
- 6** **Cathedral-Basilica of Notre-Dame de Québec**  
One of Canada's oldest churches located in Quebec's Historic District (Map-1,2,3)
- 7** **Chevalier House**  
Fascinating historic home-turned-museum in Quebec City's Old Port district (Map-1,2,3)
- 8** **Château Frontenac**  
Quebec's famous luxury hotel with a rich history offers spectacular views of the St. Lawrence River (Map-1,2,3)
- 9** **La Citadelle**  
Large fort built at the highest natural point in the area and home to the Royal 22e Regiment (Map-1,2)
- 10** **La Promenade Samuel-De Champlain**  
A 2.5 km park along the St. Lawrence River gifted to the city for its 400th anniversary (Map-1)
- 11** **Montmorency Falls**  
Higher than Niagara Falls and beautiful to visit throughout the year
- 12** **Morrin Centre**  
English-speakers cultural center housed in a former prison (Map-1,2,3)
- 13** **Musee du Fort**  
The battles of Quebec come to life in a fascinating Sound and Light show in this military museum (Map-1,2,3)
- 14** **Museum of French America**  
Housed in the centuries old Seminaire de Quebec, tracing Francophone culture in North America (Map-1,2,3)
- 15** **Musée National des Beaux-Arts du Québec**  
Located in Battlefield Park, this art museum has works spanning several centuries (Map-1)
- 16** **Musée de la Civilisation**  
Fascinating interactive museum presenting the culture and history of Quebec (Map-1,2,3)
- 17** **Musée des Ursulines**  
Dedicated to the fascinating history of Quebec's oldest religious order dating from the 17th century (Map-1,2,3)
- 18** **Notre Dame des Victoires Church**  
One of the first stone churches in Canada and dedicated to French victory over Britain (Map-1,2,3)
- 19** **Observatoire de la Capitale**  
Spectacular 360 degree views of Quebec from one of the tallest points in the city (Map-1,2)
- 20** **Old Port**  
Historic port boasting multiple art galleries, antique shops, the Old Port Market and a great nightlife scene (Map-1)
- 21** **Old Quebec**  
Historical neighborhood featuring some of Quebec's most fascinating landmarks (Map-1,2,3)
- 22** **Old Quebec Funicular**  
19th century funicular railway linking Upper Town and Lower Town in the Old Quebec (Map-1,2,3)
- 23** **Parc du Bois-de-Coulonge**  
One of Quebec's most beautiful urban parks covering 27 hectares (Map-1)
- 24** **Place Royale**  
Picturesque and beautifully restored plaza considered the birthplace of French America (Map-1,2,3)
- 25** **Plains of Abraham Park & Museum**  
Urban park commemorating the major battle between French and English troops in 1759 (Map-1,2)
- 26** **Quartier du Petit Champlain**  
Historically preserved, picturesque cobble-stoned district dating back to 1608 (Map-1,2,3)
- 27** **Quebec Parliament Building**  
The 1866 Quebec Parliament Building has an interesting shape and facade (Map-1,2)
- 28** **Ramparts of Quebec City**  
Quebec City's historical fortified walls date back to the 17th century (Map-1,2)
- 29** **Saint-Louis Forts and Châteaux**  
Archaeological remains of two centuries of English residence above the St. Lawrence River (Map-1,2,3)
- 30** **Sainte Anne de Beaupre Basilica**  
17th century Catholic church famous for its legendary healing powers
